6th FIAP CLUBS' WORLD CUP

Introduction by Jacky Martin, Vice-President of FIAP

With an increase of nearly 20%, the 2010 participation confirmed that the modification of the regulation, allowing now to participate with only 5 authors per club, opened the World Cup to clubs so far excluded from the competition.

The first 5 editions of the Clubs' World Cup saw clubs from 5 different countries get this top award of FIAP. After **Wigan 10 Foto Club (Great Britain)** in 2006, **GF II Cupolone (Italy)** in 2007, **Foto Club Quilmes (Argentina)** in 2008, the club **Iris Lede (Belgium)** in 2009, the **Dundalk Photographic Society (Ireland)** brilliantly won the fifth World Cup. Who will be next in 2011? Perhaps your club ...

In 2010 we innovated with the creation of a new FIAP trophy, the **Maurice Dorikens Trophy** that rewards the most consistent club over 5 consecutive years. It is still the **Wigan 10 Foto Club** which was the first recipient of this new award. The information on this award is available on the FIAP website, from the results page of the 2010 World Cup.

I recall that all ILFIAP clubs can enter the World Cup for free. Each of their participation enables them to gain 5 basic points of acceptance, which can be combined with individual acceptances for new club distinctions CAFIAP and CEFIAP. I am pleased to note that several ILFIAP clubs have already accumulated enough acceptances to run for the distinction CAFIAP.

INVITATION

The International Federation of Photographic Art, invites you to take part in the **6th FIAP Clubs' World Cup** to be held in **PARIS** from 8/10/11 to 28/02/12.

CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

Each club, member of FIAP or not may enter a CD-Rom containing 20 colour and/or black and white digital works. **At most 4 works per author.**

There is no coherence required between works.

Operational Members cannot participate.

Please note the new rules : 20 works mandatory, 4 photos maximum per author.

WORKS SIZE

Files will be RGB mode, JPG 10 compressed, 300dpi, 2400 pixels minimum for the larger side in order to be printed for the exhibition.

Files will be named **01_club-name, 02_club-name** up to **20_club-name**.

The Excel entry-form (00_club-name.xls) must be on the CD-Rom with the works.

ENTRY FEE

There is no fee for ILFIAP Clubs, which already pay a member fee to FIAP.

The entry fee is **50€** (no \$) per club no FIAP member, to be paid :

PRIZES

The FIAP Clubs' World Cup is awarded as follows :

Clubs' World Cup for the best club.

FIAP Gold medal for the club which comes second.

FIAP Silver medal for the club which comes third.

FIAP Bronze medal for the club which comes fourth.

Six honourable mentions for the clubs which come 5th to 10th.

The authors of the club coming first receive an honourable mention.

One FIAP gold medal, two FIAP silver medals and three FIAP bronze medals will award works of exceptional quality, independently of the clubs' classification.

Each judge will choose his special favourite.

Each author can only receive one prize.

The Club having got the best results from 2007 to 2011, will receive the **Maurice Dorikens Trophy 2007-2011**.

CATALOGUE – EXHIBITION

Each participating club will receive a catalogue on CD-Rom.

All accepted works will be reproduced in the catalogue.

Prize-winning works as well as one work per author from the Club winner of the World Cup will be shown at the FIAP headquarters gallery.
